Roundup Guidelines:

- 1. Students, if you are awarded a scholarship for any amount or selected to participate in an extracurricular experience, please notify Mrs. <u>Jessica Gesualdo</u> in the Career Center as soon as possible.
- 2. Please view scholarship "Action" located under scholarship deadline for procedural instructions.
- 3. Parents, ONLY AHS faculty and staff members may nominate students for scholarships and extracurricular opportunities. Students may also nominate themselves. All nominations should be emailed to Mrs. Jessica Gesualdo and should include :
 - The student's first and last name
 - The name of the award(s) in which you are nominating him or her

Students, if you are nominating yourself, please include the same information. Please note that you can nominate more than one student per opportunity or for several opportunities. Not all scholarships require response nomination.

AHS Nomination-Only Scholarships and Opportunities

1. <u>Quest Bridge College Prep Scholarship</u> – Monetary / Enrichment

Opportunities Vary

Deadline: Online application due March 26, 2014

Action: AHS Faculty and Staff may <u>refer</u> a student to apply OR student may complete online application without initial referral. Student applicants must have a recommendation as part of complete application.

Qualifications:

- Student must be a junior in high school planning to apply to college during the Fall of their senior year
- Student must demonstrate outstanding academic ability despite facing economic challenges
- Additional selection criteria are listed here

College-Specific Scholarships

2. Emmanuel College - \$500 Referral Scholarship

Deadline: Referrals distributed on a first come, first serve basis. SEVEN scholarships are currently available.

Action: Refer student to The Career Center to obtain scholarship referral card and administrator's signature.

Qualifications:

- Only for first-time, full time students strongly considering or committed to enrolling at Emmanuel College
- Student must register referral card at the above link
- Student must present referral card to Emmanuel College Financial Aid Counselor

4. Nordstrom Scholarship – "10 4 U" (10K)

Deadline: May 1, 2014 **Action:** Student must submit <u>online application</u>; please review <u>application guidelines</u> **Nominee Qualifications**:

- Student must not be a current high school junior
- Student must have at least a 2.7 GPA
- > Must volunteer or participate in community service or extracurricular activities
- Must plan on attending an accredited four-year college or university
- > Must plan on applying for financial assistance in order to attend college

Deadline: March 31, 2014

Action: Student must complete application and mail to Univision Atlanta (address is located at the bottom of the application); view attached "Univision Rules and Regulations" before applying

Nominee Qualifications:

- Student must not be a current high school senior on track for graduation in Spring 2014
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Student must be of Hispanic descent
