- 3. Parents, ONLY AHS faculty and staff members may nominate students for scholarships and extracurricular opportunities. Students may also nominate themselves. All nominations should be emailed to <u>Mrs. Gesualdo</u> and should include:
  - a. The student's first and last name
  - b. The name of the award(s) in which you are nominating him or her
  - c. Students, if you are nominating yourself, please include the same information.
- 4. Please note that you can nominate more than one student per opportunity or for several opportunities. Not all scholarships require response nomination.
- 5. If you would like AHS to mail your completed applications, they **MUST be turned into the Career Center by May 15, 2014.**
